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PREVIOUS WORK

Cypress Bluff, Groveland, Florida

Located between Villa City Rd to the west and Lake Lucy to the east, Cypress Bluff is a new community developed under Groveland’s new code and comprehensive plan. Once built the community will contain close to 400 dwellings, a ‘main street, various neighborhood parks and greens, trails, and a viewing tower at the top of the bluff, with expansive views of the rolling hills and lakes of Groveland and Lake County.

The Preserve at Lake David, Groveland, Florida

Located on a unique property just to the west of Downtown Groveland, The Preserve at Lake David is a geographically private enclave community surrounded by wetlands and forests. This community utilizes innovative residential design in order to maximize value and create great community design. Once built the community will contain about 80 dwellings on lots ranging from just 32’ to 60’. Envisioned with a Florida-friendly low-impact design overall, the entire community will be encircled by a low-impact trail along the wetland buffer, providing a great amenity for residents.

City Mark | Orlando, Florida*

Located at the intersection of Interstate 4 and Florida’s Turnpike on the Delta Resort property, City Mark is a +/-28 acre mixed-use vision that incorporates four condominium towers, hotel, low-rise residential and retail / restaurant space. The creation is centered on a green public core that provides a variety of social spaces and unique features such as amphitheater, open lawn and various water features.
