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### PREVIOUS WORK

#### Cypress Bluff, Groveland, Florida

Located between Villa City Rd to the west and Lake Lucy to the east, Cypress Bluff is a new community developed under Groveland’s new code and comprehensive plan. Once built the community will contain close to 400 dwellings, a ‘main street, various neighborhood parks and greens, trails, and a viewing tower at the top of the bluff, with expansive views of the rolling hills and lakes of Groveland and Lake County.

#### Rainwood, Groveland, Florida

Located in Groveland, Florida adjacent to Wilson Lake Parkway, Rainwood is a proposed development of an 132-acre mixed-use community which falls under the Village Code Regulations in Groveland’s new Form-Based Code and Comprehensive Plan. The community will include office/retail, live-works, townhomes, bungalow homes, garden homes, and large lot estate homes, along with an array of amenitized open spaces and community amenities. A connected network of streets helps to create a walkable community. A number of homes in Rainwood front directly on to green spaces, adding to the natural charm of this new community. Community amenities are centered on terminating vistas which make the most of the site’s unique topography.

#### Peachtree Hills, Groveland, Florida

Located in Groveland, Florida north of the Turnpike and Ford Commerce Park, Peachtree Hills will be a mixed-use community that follows the intent of the Hamlet Community Type in Groveland’s new Code and Comprehensive Plan. Three distinct neighborhoods form the primary layout of the community. The community will include a mix of live-works, townhomes, bungalow homes, garden homes and large lot estate homes, along with ample open spaces. Some of these opens spaces will be programmed as centralized parks and greens, while others are intended to be more natural in scope. In addition to a central community amenity center, there will be a small peachtree orchard which pays homage to this region’s agricultural roots.
